## Karen Frederick, Curator of Exhibitions & Collections Greenwich Historical Society (retired 2020)

Karen was at the Scarsdale Historical Society and then curator of exhibitions at Greenwich Historical Society for 19 years. Karen hired Kathy to do some exhibits at both Scarsdale and GHS. She gives Kathy her highest recommendation and said:

- Kathy is an extraordinary curator.
