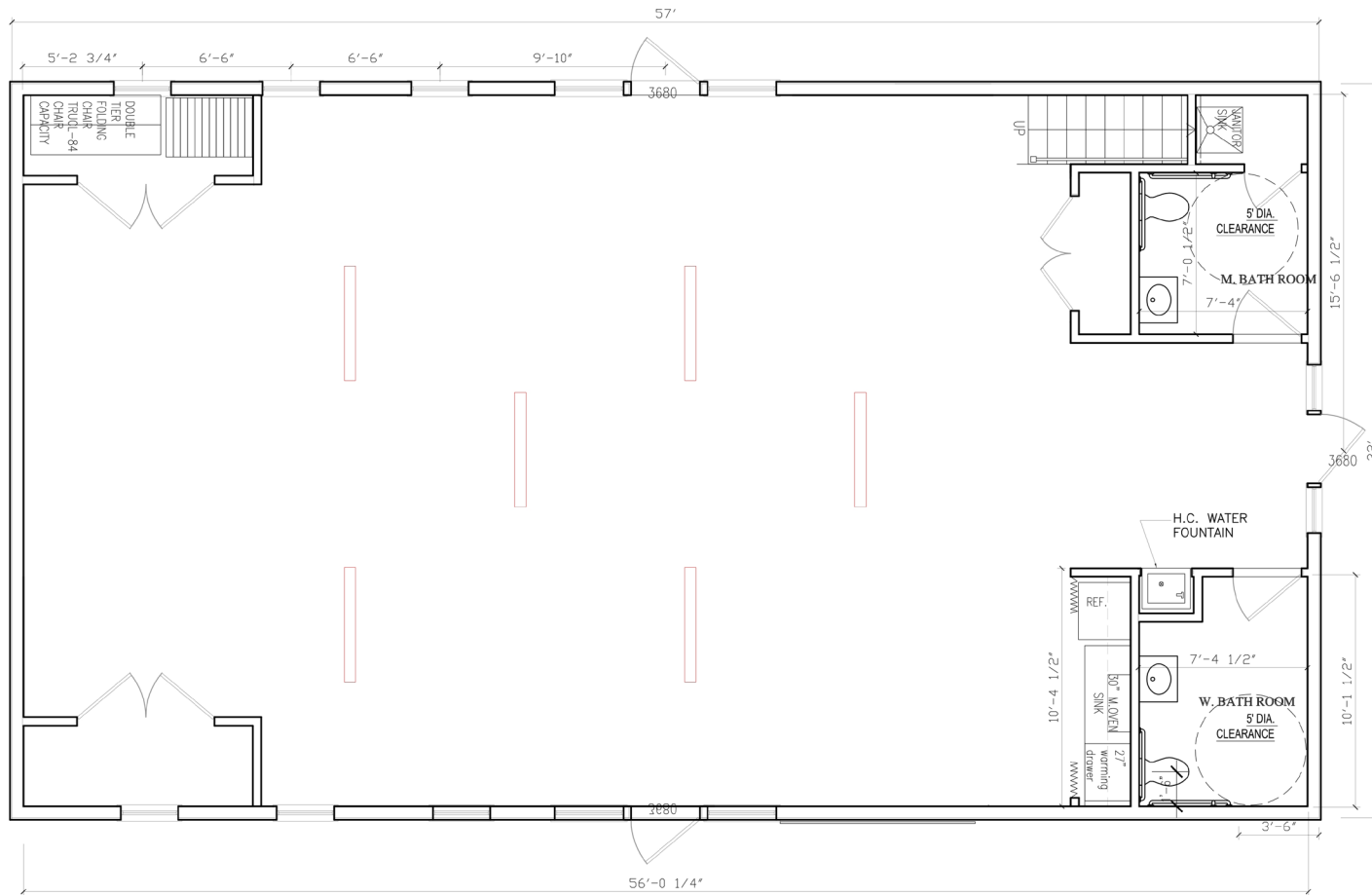
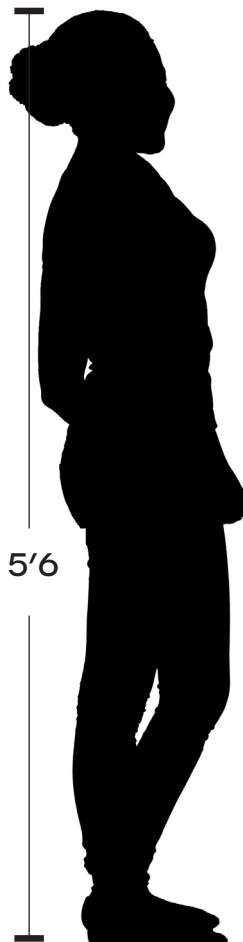

Note on Image Resolution

Through our photo research we have learned that only low resolution images of the National Parks are free or low cost (\$150 or less).

In the design on p. 3, the photo is 40x60". This might not be the exact size that we decide on but it's a good place to start. There are two options:

1. Use the lower resolution images and apply a soft blur
2. Purchase a sharper, cleaner image at an additional cost. A photographer who has a large catalog of NP images has offered to provide image rights to the Mather Homestead at a reduced rate since he's an admirer of Stephen Mather. The cost would be \$450 per image and we would need 8 images at least.

The following three pages show details of the images, if they were blown up to 40x60". They are:

1. Free, low resolution without a blur
2. Free, low resolution with a blur
3. Photographer, \$450

Installation: They will arrive assembled so there won't be significant installation costs.

This is incorrect. Do not unfold silicone edging



Start with one corner.
Sewn edge of silicone goes in first



Put in 5-6" before going to diagonal corner



Once first corner is in go to diagonal corner and repeat



3rd- stick in opposite side corner



4th-stretch fabric to get the last corner in. This should be a snug fit



Lastly push in the middles of each side and work your way outwards



Push the corners in with any key if necessary



Fabric should be snug, almost as if you could bounce a quarter

Charisma Frame™ - XSM Series Mounting Options

Wall Mount

Wall Mount Brackets

1. Mount top brackets onto wall. Use optional molly anchors if mounting to drywall.
2. Slide frame onto top brackets.
3. Mount bottom brackets to wall to secure frame. Use optional molly anchors if mounting to drywall.

Distortion Brackets - For leveling frame and eliminating sagging.

4. Mount top brackets onto wall. Use optional molly anchors if mounting to drywall.
5. Slide frame onto top brackets tighten adjustable screw so that it rests inside the frame channel.
6. Mount bottom brackets to wall to secure frame. Use optional molly anchors if mounting to drywall. Tighten adjustable screw so that it rests inside the frame channel.

XSMA (Single-Sided Frame) and XSMB (Double-Sided Frame)

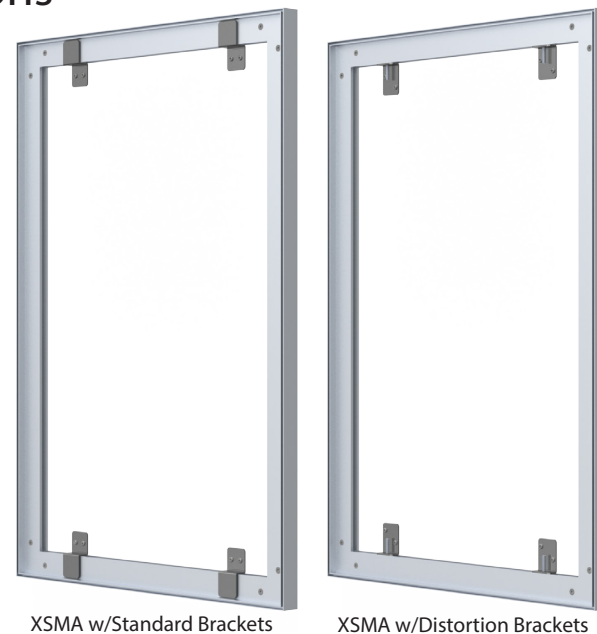
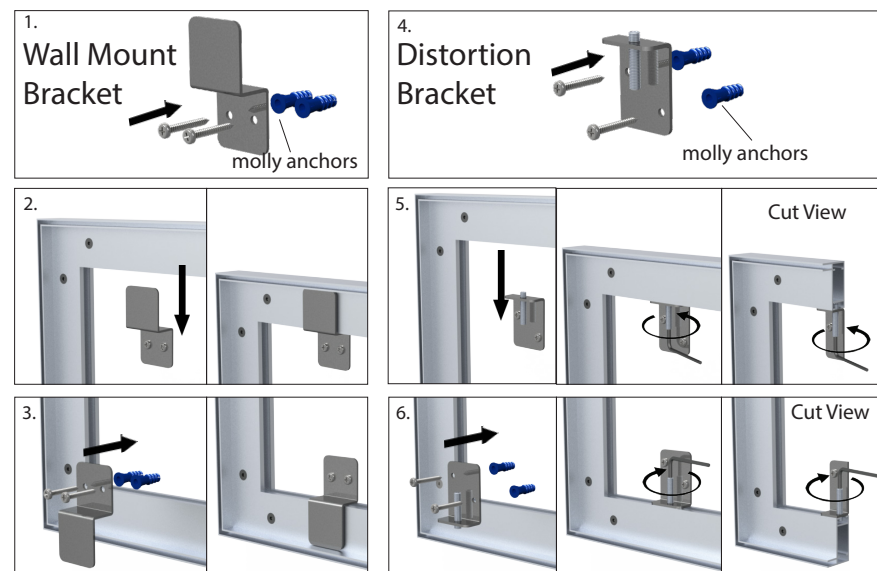
7. Connect hanging wires to eyebolts on frame.

XSMA (Single-Sided Frame) and XSMB (Double-Sided Frame)

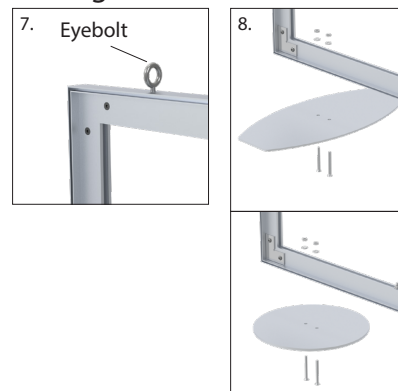
8. Determine base style. Attached the base to the frame using the Phillips screws provided.

NOTE: Size of frame may differ, instructions remain the same.

XSMA/XSMB with Base Plates

Charisma SEG with MegaBase, -MB option

1. Mount the base to the frame using the screws provided. Screws will connect to both the side and bottom of the frame.

Note: The number of screw connection points might vary from what is shown, but assembly instructions remain the same.
